**Friday:** For those staying in the Mountains, cocktails at the Ivanhoe Hotel, and dinner at the Italian Restaurant, both in Blackheath (at own cost).

**Saturday 10.30am-1.30pm:** Drawing/Painting in the landscape (Location 1).

**Saturday 2.30-5.30pm:** Painting in studio/classroom using your morning studies or in Location 2.

**Saturday evening:** A glass or two of still or sparkling wine and/or orange juice (cost included) at Hargraves Lookout on the Shipley Plateau (car sharing required).

BBQ Dinner and wine at Artist's home and a sticky beak at the garden studio (cost included).

**Sunday 10am-1.30pm:** Painting/drawing in the landscape (Location 3) followed by lunch at The Gardeners Inn Bistro, Blackheath (own cost).

Discover the vintage shopping and galleries in Blackheath and Leura; Visit the major tourist attractions in the Blue Mountains area; or just make your way home when you like.
